Barra Church Victory Report January 2016 – New Outstation

We have a new outstation open this time. This is a place wherein Ret. Bishop E.W. Wheeler use to visit preach and teach way back in the year 1984 together with my brother Late Pastor Joe Barrero, which was located in the mountain ranges of Misamis Oriental. The barangay is Sto.Rosario municipality of Tagoloan, it is about forty five kilometers away from Barra Church, the same highway if we are going to Lanise Church. 1984 that said barangay is really difficult to reach due to the condition of the road, only motorcycle and working animals such as horse is their source of transportation. There was a church in that barangay whose Pastor's name is Pastor Dalangba. According to the history of his family he has seventeen children. Pastor Dalangba was so very active in his ministry, he has many church members and very loyal to Apostolic Ministers Fellowship. But then the same year he died at the age of 59. I remember in his funeral I was present together with Ret. Bishop E.W. Wheeler who then the speaker in that funeral rites together with A.M.F Preachers.

After a few years the church members of late Pastor Dalangba together with his children scattered out, no pastors continue the work in the church of Sto.Rosario until this time, thirty years 30 ago. Last December 2015, I encouraged one of my church members a relative of Dalangba to visit Sto. Rosario, to look the children of late Pastor Dalangba. She found out that three children of late Pastor Dalangba are waiting for us to visit them. Last Friday January 15, 2016 together with Sis. Barrero, with some church members from Lanise and Barra also Pastor Longhino Playto were there in Sto. Rosario, Tagoloan, Mis.Or. Right there we meet the four families, they were crying and willing to submit and continue to serve the Lord. This coming Sunday January 24, 2016, we will open outstation service there in Sto. Rosario, Tagoloan, Mis. Or. I give an assignment to one of our young people in Lanise Bro. Joey Gomez who finish ACTS Bible School to work in the area with my close supervision.
