CAMBODIA UPDATE

"We appreciate all the prayers and support for this new work in Cambodia."

We are so grateful for more good news from our new work in Cambodia. The two couple there - the Vanns and the Minhs recently traveled about 60 miles to Kampong Cham by motorbike to conduct a Bible study with a young lady named Nien who was suffering oppression from evil spirits. During the course of the Bible study, Bro. Hong and Bro. Nhut had Nien to remove her idols from her purse. She used these idols to worship Chinese gods. Tuan, a young man who is also taking a Bible study, helped burn the idols. After destroying those idols, they prayed for Nien and felt the presence of God. We trust that Tuan and Nien will accept the Truth and live for God. (We included some pictures.)

These two couples have also been working with another family who once lived in Kampong Cham province, but moved to the Phnom Penh area due to some difficulties they were facing. It was these difficulties that seemed to soften this family, who recently had a Bible study. Bro. Nhut spoke to them in Vietnamese while Bro. Hong interpreted into Khmer and English. We trust this family will be hungry for the truth.

These two couples are also working with a young couple. The man's name is My and the lady's name is Mai. Since they conceived a child out of wedlock the parents were practicing witchcraft against the Mai and taking steps to force her to have an abortion. This young couple decided to pray to Jesus to help them in this difficult time. They realize that it was a miracle that they were able to save their baby. We included a picture of the baby and hope God will lead this young couple into the Truth.

We appreciate all the prayers and support for this new work in Cambodia. We receive regular reports of the daily activities of these two fine couples. They are very dedicated to the work of God and faithfully spread the Gospel. We believe God will give the increase. I look forward to visiting this work early next year.
