The report came back that it was cancer and recommended chemotherapy. After the first treatment, tests came back negative. The doctor wept when he gave the good news. We thank God for this wonderful miracle.

The Miembans are charter members of the church I started in 1980. They have not only been faithful pillars since then, but have been great soul-winners. At a conference several years ago, we had all the people stand who were the fruit of this good family. Over 40 people stood! That did not include those who were still serving God, unable to attend the conference.

Since Bro. Miemban is a master artist, he has turned down many, many invitations for opportunities outside the country. Although these would have offered a far greater income - often as much as ten times his earnings in the Philippines, he always put church and family first and God has blessed him for those decisions.

Being an artist, Bro. Miemban enjoys a flexible schedule. For several years, he has chosen to work at his profession only three days each week. The other four days are for God. He and Sis. Miemban are faithful to help branch works; give Bible Studies; and work in outreach for the children. They have become an important part of the aggressive outreach program in the Bagong Silang Church. He also teaches in the Bible college.

Isla Talim, Binangonan Rizal Victory Report of Bro. Meimban

Praise the Lord! We're so thankful for what the Lord has done to Bro. Meimban.

Since **February 2013**, Bro. Meimban is experiencing some pains and sometimes he collapse due to low hemoglobin count and feeling of deterioration due to these he underwent series of check-ups and examinations to find out the cause of ailments.

In **May 27, Monday** he pursues to all of his requires examination, such as CT scan really cost a lot but God provide.

May 31, Friday, we got the result of his CT scan shows that; there is a 10.1 cm long circumferential mucosal wall thickening in the ascending colon and cecum with adjacent precolonic fat stranding and sub centimeter lymph nodes. He was suggested for another examination called colonoscopy for better evaluation and also this examination cost a lot and God still continue provides our needs.

Because of his low hemoglobin count, in **June 03, Monday** he was confined in the Hospital for blood transfusion, five bags of blood and preparing for colonoscopy laboratory examination.

June 05, Wednesday He underwent Colonoscopy examine and we found out the cyst is severely bleeding and continue enlarging, clogging the bowel passage. The doctor told to the family to pursue immediate major operation.

June 06, Thursday the two Elder's (Elder Barrero and Elder Cajanding with Pastor Balmes) visit in the Hospital to encourage him and pray over him anticipating his coming major operation, also asking the perfect will of God for Bro. Meimban.

June 07, Friday after the operation the doctor called Sis. Balmes to show to her the cyst gotten from his father colon. The doctor impression according to his experiences, that this kind of cyst is malignant stage 3 of cancer, as he continue he says that he might need to undergo high dosage of chemotherapy to help him to survive. The doctor also said; let's just pray for God's grace for him.

All family of Meimban's still trusted in God for His Perfect will.

Churches all over the Indo China, Philippines and America joined in prayer for Bro. Meimban .

After 3 weeks we received the result of his biopsy. We found out that it's only in stage 2 completely negative for malignant cells. However, he will still needs to pursue low dosage of chemotherapy for his colonic wall.

Thank God for the GREAT MIRACLE. The Doctor even says that it's miracle from GOD, because he had patients with this kind of situation his diagnosis is malignant and only few survive. But at this time the doctor said; "It's miracle from God. Praise the Lord.

Thank God for His provisions supplying not only some needs but all needs.

God used many people to supply all the amount of Bro. Meimban hospitalization and medication.

We believe God saw all of the Meimban's good labor working as soul winners in the church since began.

The whole Family of Bro. Meimban wants to extend all thanks to God first, second, to our Bishop E.W Wheeler and Ma'am Wheeler who loves us, to all the Elders and Pastors and to all the Churches from America, Indo China and Philippine who helped us in prayer. And all other people who were used by God to supply the entire amount we need.
